Do you ever think, "I must be the last person to know," when it comes to a cer-

tain subject? I've recently had that experience when it comes to the catchy children's song, "Baby Shark," that seems to

be just about everywhere, now that I'm finally in-the-know. Having only adult children and no grandchildren, I guess I have some excuse for my extended ignorance. When our kids were much younger, everything was about Barney the Purple Dinosaur, so it was only back in August that I can recall my wife mentioning for the first time that our two grandnieces, my brother and sister-in-law's granddaughters, are really into "Baby Shark". My wife was obviously up on it, because she would occasionally sing the first verse with its well-known simple words: Baby Shark doo doo doo doo doo doo. (Trust me, I struggle with the timing when it comes to correctly repeating doo 6-times and my wife thinks it's hilarious.) I started to notice our children were using Baby Shark memes in our family text messages and commentators/DJs on the radio were making frequent Baby Shark references. Even I realized there must be more to this.

Finally, in late September, I typed "Baby Shark" into Goggle and watched a YouTube video of the entire song with lyrics. Who knew (probably everyone else besides me) that there are actually nine verses to the simple song that go in order: Baby Shark, Mommy Shark, Daddy Shark, Grandma Shark, Grandpa Shark, Let's Go Hunt, Run Away, Safe at Last, and It's the End (all accompanied by upbeat doo doo doo doo doo's). After acquiring this new knowledge from the Internet, I told my wife that verse 6, Let's Go Hunt doo doo doo doo doo (that's easier for me to type than sing) is my and my brother's new theme song for this Fall. To which she immediately replied, "Run Away" and "Safe at Last" are the deer and other critters' official theme songs. If you watched any of the MLB playoffs or the World Series, vou probably noticed "Baby Shark' was the Washington National's theme song during their championship run, which included repeatedly playing the song at their stadium, hand motions from the players and fans, a stuffed "Baby Shark" in their dugout, and several fans wearing "Baby Shark" costumes. I'm thinking about making "Let's Go Hunt" the alarm tone on my smartphone, but I'm guessing my wife would vote "No" on the idea of having that come on in the early morning darkness.

Speaking of "Let's Go Hunt" and ideas, my brother and I have both had the same plan for the past few years, ever since the PA Game Commission initiated a bear archery season. The plan is to harvest a doe on the first day of bear archery (since deer archery is concurrently open) and then patiently watch the remaining gut pile for an extended period to take a bear or possibly a coyote, that comes in to eat the remaining offal. (I first checked with the PGC and they said it is perfectly legal, since the deer gut pile would be created in the act of hunting where the deer fell and it was not artificially placed there as a means of illegally baiting a bear. (Bears and covotes have been living off left over gut piles for as long as hunters have been harvesting whitetails.) So, Mon., Oct. 28, first-thing in the morning, my brother, Craig, took a nice doe on his property out East, while over 200-miles West of him, I took a mature doe up in Venango County.

That's when our bear archery vigils started. While my gut pile started to disappear a little at a time, probably from gray fox at night, which past trail camera photos revealed; my brother's patience was handsomely rewarded at 8:17 AM on Wed., Oct. 30. Craig took his first PA archery black bear less than 200-yards from their home, up on the Blue Mountain. It was a beautiful male with an estimated liveweight of 211 lbs. when they took it to the PGC check station. It was the first bear taken this year in Lehigh County and Craig's second PA black bear. (He previously harvested a 255 lb. sow with a rifle in 2005.) I'm incredibly happy for Craig and it inspires me to keep heading out each day, so "Let's Go Hunt"! ©WBB 2019

Proper Disposal Tires

A Guide to Doing it right in Lawrence and Mercer Counties

Tires?

We discard a lot of tires. Estimates are that we scrap more than 300 million tires annually. Tires are designed to last a long time and as a result are very persistent in the environment. Tires are classified as municipal waste by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, however, similar to some other common household wastes, they can pose serious health, safety, and environmental issues if not properly managed. The good news is that tires are 100% recyclable or useable as an alternative energy source.

What are the concerns about improperly discarded Tires?

• Health risks. Tires are ideal breeding areas for mosquitoes as the mosquitoes will lay their eggs in the stagnant water that collects in them. Different mosquito varieties can carry serious diseases such as dengue fever, Zika, and encephalitis (caused by the West Nile virus). The U.S. Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommends removing tires from your property because of these risks.

• Fire risks. Tire fires can result in air pollution and in oily runoff that can contaminate soil, surface water, and ground-water. The oily material is also highly flammable. Tire fires result in thick smoke throughout the surrounding area which can contain pollutants harmful to human health including polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons, benzene, styrene, phenols, and butadiene. Tire fires also threaten nearby water supplies with harmful contaminants such as lead and arsenic contained in the oily runoff. Fires involving tires are costly and can be difficult to control and extinguish. • Illegal dumping. Tires are frequently tossed along roadways, over hillsides, and in waterways because people don't know where to take them or are too cheap to pay for proper disposal. Illegally dumped tires breed mosquitoes and other vectors, lower property values, encourage more dumping, and waste tax money because they are expensive to remove once they have been dumped.

• Landfill space. Tires do not compact well and take up valuable space in landfills. In Pennsylvania, whole tires are banned from landfill disposal.

What happens to properly disposed tires?

Tires may be shredded, retreaded, used as an alternative fuel source, or cut into quarters and landfilled. Shredded tires are recycled into crumb rubber that is used in landscape projects, molded rubber goods, civil engineering projects, and athletic fields.

Where can I take my old tires?

• Many tire dealers will accept small quantities (ten or less) from residents. Be sure to call your tire dealer for information. Fees will apply and may vary depending on the tire contractor your dealer is using.

• Annual collection programs for tires are hosted by two local non-profits: Shenango River Watchers and Tri-County CleanWays. Hermitage residents have access to a program offered by their municipality.

• The easiest way to avoid the need to dispose of old tires is to recycle your tires when you buy new ones.





Proper Disposal Fluorescent Lamps

A Guide to Doing it right in Lawrence and Mercer Counties

What are fluorescent lamps?

Fluorescent lamps, also called fluorescent lights, come in two forms, linear and compact. They use a low pressure Mercury vapor with fluorescence to produce visible light. Fluorescent lamps have many applications and are more energy efficient then their incandescent counterparts. Compact fluorescent lights (CFLs) were developed as a replacement for regular household incandescent lights. Linear lamps are used in shops, buildings, basements, etc. Linear lamps may also come in different shapes such as round or Ushaped.

There are other forms of fluorescent lamps including: black and tanning lights, UVB medical, grow, infrared, bilirubin, germicidal, electrodeless, and cold-cathode fluorescent lamps.

What are the concerns about improperly discarded Fluorescent lamps?

Fluorescent lamps contain Mercury. Mercury is an extremely toxic element that must be handled and managed carefully. Exposure to Mercury can severely damage (depending on the dosage) the brain, kidneys, and lungs and is responsible for several diseases. Exposure may occur when a lamp is broken resulting in the release of Mercury vapor.

The amount of Mercury contained in CFL's is extremely low. By comparison, the amount of Mercury contained in a single older style thermostat is the equivalent of 125 CFL's. Linear lamps generally contain higher amounts of Mercury that will vary with bulb size and manufacturer.

Although the amount of Mercury released from a bulb or two that you may put in your trash will be minimal, it is the cumulative effect that we need to be concerned about. Your bulb or two will add up with the thousands and tens of thousands of other households that did the same thing.

Why should I use Fluorescent lights if they are potentially toxic?

Our trash has changed dramatically over the past two decades, becoming much more toxic. Items such as electronics and batteries contain potentially hazardous materials but are frequently tossed in the trash.

Fluorescent lamps are no exception. Fortunately, these hazardous materials are recyclable. Fluorescent lamp benefits far outweigh the hazards which are significantly reduced when the lamps

are properly recycled. Fluorescent lamps are extremely energy efficient compared to their traditional incandescent counterparts. According to the U.S. Energy Star program, if every household replaced one incandescent with a Fluorescent light, it would be the equivalent of reducing the greenhouse gases from 800,000 vehicles. Energy saved reduces the amount of coal necessary to be burned for electricity generation. Power plants are the largest source of Mercury emissions in the U.S.

As a result of their energy efficiency Fluorescent lamps are cheaper to operate. They also give off one-fifth the heat of an incandescent lamp which can be beneficial in buildings with few windows and many lights.

Where can I take my old Fluorescent lamps?

• Outlets for CFL's include: Lowes, Home Depot, ECS&R, and some HHW collections.

• Fluorescent tubes have limited options: ECS&R and special collection programs.

• Mail-in recycling options also exist for Fluorescent lights. There is a cost associated with mail programs that includes prepaid shipping labels and packaging.

• The Lawrence-Mercer Recycling/Solid Waste Department can provide you with the latest list of options.


