



**Different Options for Fall Excursions: The** Panhandle Trail and Lake Wilhelm's Upper Pool (Part 2 of 4)

There are many reasons why I like riding and walking on rails-to-trails projects. These trail corridors, which are constructed on former railroad rightof-ways, typically do not exceed a 1% incline grade (one foot of rise for every 100-feet traveled), due to the amount of locomotive power required to pull heavily loaded trains up these hills. That is why many rails-to-trails projects seem like you are steadily climbing for miles and miles, because you actually are. (There are exceptions, such as the Stavich Bike Trail, which follows a former trolley right-of-way and has portions that exceed a 1% incline.) Most rails-to-trails projects provide incline charts on their websites and in their promotional literature, which clearly show the incline percentages for each portion of the trail. This information enables riders/walkers to anticipate what's coming up ahead. Through experience, I've learned to look at these incline charts when planning our bike rides, especially when we're completing a longer trail in multiple sections, so we can ride the significant uphill portions on the way out to our turnaround point (when you have the most energy) and then you have the luxury of the downhill grade on the way back. Frequently, you'll find you don't actually realize how much elevation you've slowly gained on the way out, until you ride back down the same extended grade and get to take advantage of the leisurely downhill with some coasting included.

After completing the eastern third of the 29.5-mile Panhandle Trail (PT) on April 24, we skipped a Friday's ride on May 8, due to the fact winter weather decide to return for one last hurrah. My son and I went back out on Friday, May 22, and completed the middle third of the PT, riding west from the parking area at the Primrose/Noblestown Road Crossing (MM 8.8) by the Fort Cherry Ambulance Station (a few miles west of McDonald, PA), over past Burgettstown. We turned around approximately 1.5 miles west of Burgettstown at the top of the grade (MM 18.4), where a recently installed natural gas pipeline crosses the PT. Our turnaround was slightly more than <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>-mile east of the Dinsmore Road parking area. This middle third of the PT traverses Washington County and took us through several miles of rolling reclaimed strip-mine lands and past quaint small towns, such as Midway, Bulger, and Joffre.

With two-thirds of the PT completed, we were anxious to complete the final third on June 5. Having reviewed the



incline chart, my son and I decided it

was prudent to meet at the Harmon

Creek parking area, just off US-22, near

Weirton, WV. Not wanting to skip any

portion of the entire PT, we initially

rode west for just under a mile to the

trail's unceremonious western termi-

nus at a pile of gravel, before heading

eastbound on the PT's long, gradual

ascent. The first 4-miles in Hancock

County, WV paralleled Harmon Creek

and my son caught sight of a rather

large beaver by the waterway that I

somehow missed as we rode past. The

next 6-miles in Washington County, PA

took us primarily through wooded ar-

eas, which I'm sure will be even more

scenic, once the leaves turn colors in

the upcoming weeks. We eventually

reached our turnaround at the natural

gas pipeline crossing, just east of the

Dinsmore Road parking area. The 10-

mile ride back to our vehicles was a

breeze, because it was almost all down-

hill, and we only stopped briefly to take a few photos by the interesting railroad

After three trips and close to 60-miles

on our hybrid bikes, we were happy to

have ridden the entire Panhandle Trail

give your legs a workout, I find it's always good to mix in a regular paddling excursion to provide your upper body with an equal opportunity. With the sheer number of kayaks you see on roof racks, in truck beds, and loaded on trailers, it's very apparent many folks agree. Like many paddlers, I'm always in search of new waters to quietly explore by human propulsion. One waterway we have made a regular destination in 2020 is the upper pool of Lake Wilhelm at Goddard State Park in neighboring Mercer County. Most folks are familiar with the vast majority of Lake Wilhelm, which stretches almost 6-miles from the I-79 bridges, all the way down to the dam near Sandy Lake, PA. This is primarily the realm of pontoon boats and fishermen, but there is an upper, less visited pool that stretches westward from the I-79 bridges another 1.5-miles where outboard motors are not permitted. 


