Paws Corner by Sam Mazzotta

DEAR PAW'S CORNER: I have an opportunity to adopt a wonderful three-legged, overweight. 4-year-old Shepherd. I'm happy to help him lose the weight, as I already walk 2 to 4 miles almost every day. However, I'm not sure if he can walk those distances. Can he be trained to walk with me that far? Do you think he would be able to swim for exercise? - Donna P., via email

DEAR DONNA: I've met so many animals that, despite a challenge such as a missing limb or paralysis, are still energetic and participate in every facet of life that they can.

Your potential new family member may be able to train up to walking a couple of miles, eventually. He's young enough, and Shepherds are certainly energetic enough.

His extra weight will make it difficult to manage on three legs. You can best control his weight through a diet prescribed by a veterinarian, rather than relying on exercise alone. Don't just cut calories without guidance, as he will need to eat good-quality food to put on muscle and get strong enough to walk with you.

Swimming, if he is comfortable doing it, can be a great option to keep him exercising while putting much less stress on his joints. Introduce him to this activity gradually, and don't force him into the water. Some dogs leap right in (I'm lookin' at you, Labradors), while others are hesitant.

If you're still on the fence about adopting this wonderful boy, talk to a veterinarian to find out what challenges you will face in getting him to a healthy weight. ©2021 King Features Syndicate, Inc.





"Pizza Puzzle" **Helps Get Chores Done**

Sometimes little ones get overwhelmed when confronted with a big job - like picking up a messy room. It may seem easy enough to adults, but to them, well, where do they begin? It's easier when the tasks are broken up into chunks, and that's what this activity is all about. Get a job done, but in slices, using this simple pizza puzzle game. Here's the crafting fun:

1. Take a large plate, preferably 15 inches in diameter, turn it upside down on a piece of poster board or a craft foam sheet, and trace around it. Cut out the circle. Divide the circle into three pieces like pizza slices, and cut them out.

2. Get your child thinking about pizza toppings and then begin to cut out the basic food shapes together from construction paper or craft foam. You might decide on red pepperoni circles, green pepper squiggles and tan mushroom slices. Glue them onto the slices.

3. Cut out the numbers 1, 2 and 3 from construction paper or craft foam, and glue one on each slice. While you are doing this, decide what part of the chore each number will represent. For example, when cleaning a bedroom, the tasks might be put (1) shoes in the closet, (2) clothes in the hamper and (3) books in the basket.

4. Glue a small magnet to the back of each slice. Let dry.





Outdoor Opportunities By COL (Ret.) Grey D. Berrier II

The Joy of Pursuing a River Monster with My Dad (Part 2 of 2)

When you hear the term "big game", most people's thoughts immediately turn to hunting. However, in outdoor circles, big game are also adjectives frequently used to describe offshore deep-sea fishing for large gamefish, such as tuna and marlin. While I may be in a very small minority. I tend to think of big game fishing in Pennsylvania-centric terms, since I do 95%+ of my angling on Commonwealth waters. In my mind, I lump four species into PA big game fishing because the possibility of catching an extremely large specimen exists, they require special tackle and tactics, and the current PA state records for all four species exceed 50 lbs. Those four species are: (1) muskellunge; (2) common carp; (3) striped bass (inland); and flathead catfish. While the PA state records for muskellunge, carp, and striped bass have stood for considerable time, the current mark for flathead catfish has gone up several times in the past decade, due to the expansion of the species into new waterways by human intervention and the possibility exists that the upward trend in PA flathead catfish state records will continue in 2021 and beyond.

After I realized I probably had my initial encounter with a sizable Susquehanna flathead in July 2019, I started to do more reading on the subject and watched a lot of YouTube videos. I quickly realized my standard bass, trout, and walleve tackle wasn't going to cut it, so I broke out my former Alaska salmon 8-foot spinning rod & reel combo and respooled it with fresh 40-lb. test big game line, specifically for flathead catfish. I also purchased a prespooled 7-foot Cat Daddy rod & reel combo as an additional catfishing rod for myself, along with an assortment of large 5/0 to 7/0 circle hooks and 1 to 3 oz. sinkers to deliberately enter this new world of PA big game fishing for flatheads, armed with the proper tackle. Knowing I would be heading out with my dad on the Susquehanna River for flathead catfish, I purchased a second Cat Daddy rod & reel combo and gave it to him as an early 2021 Father's Day gift on June 3.

It's just under an hour and a half drive from my parent's home in Allentown to our family's property on the Susquehanna River, 8-miles upriver of Harrisburg. Fri., June 4, 2021 was a beautiful day and we had dad's jon boat launched on the river before noon. Flathead catfish prefer live bait to dead cut bait, but our initial efforts to catch a rock bass, bluegill, or fallfish (a member of the minnow family) to use

as bait were unsuccessful. In the past. we would typically catch one of those three species almost as frequently as we caught smallmouth bass, but I've noticed a trend over the past 5-years where rock bass, bluegills, and fallfish are getting scarcer. I'm wondering if that has something to do with the proliferation of flathead catfish as an apex predator. As a backup, I brought frozen cut bait, trout heads and shrimp, which was permitted to thaw overnight. While mid-day isn't the optimal time to pursue catfish and early June has most catfish paired up for spawning, I still thought we'd get a bite or two to prove the flathead catfish were there. After trying for several hours in numerous promising spots, we decided to focus our efforts on smallmouth bass, which seemed much more inclined to bite. Before we headed home late Friday afternoon, dad landed three smallmouths and I brought four into the boat, including a very nice 18-incher.

There is a 98-mile stretch of the lower Susquehanna River from Sunbury down to Holtwood Dam, where bass fishing is open year-round, but it is No Harvest and Immediate Release Only. We fish those designated waters, so all our smallmouth bass get immediately returned to the water, except for an occasional quick photo. Sat., June 5, 2021 was another gorgeous day to be on the river and I knew it was going to be a good day when my initial cast resulted in a respectable 14-inch smallie, in spite of my Uncle Bill taunting me from shore regarding my fishing prowess. I was using my favorite smallmouth lure, a silver/black floating Rapala minnow, this time in size 7 (7-cm /2.75-in.), tied directly to the line (no swivel). Between noon and 3 PM, we hit several spots, and I landed 11 smallmouths, while dad brought in 6, including our largest up to that point, a fine 16-inch specimen. With temps hitting 90-degrees, we went ashore around 3:15 PM for cold water and enjoyable conversation. I convinced dad to stay out of the sun, while I headed out for another hour or so before dinner. Between 3:45 and 5 PM, I was blessed to land nine additional smallmouths, including an 18.5-inch beauty and my personal best Susquehanna River smallmouth ever, which measured 22.5-inches and tipped my scale (which I had to break out) at 4.5-lbs. What a two-day trip it turned out to be pursuing river monsters and the greatest joy came not from the fish, but from the treasured time I got to spend with my dad! God Bless, Be Safe, and Great Outdoors!


