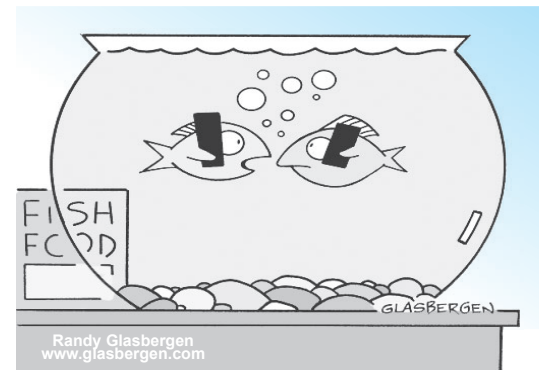

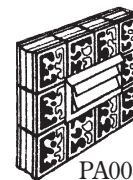

Outdoor Opportunities

**PA 2025-26 Hunting Licenses Go On Sale
June 23 & There Are Changes (Part 2 of 2)**

Wildlife Science is a science and an art. In Pennsylvania, much like most of North America, the focus is on white-tailed deer, since they have the most impact on their habitat, other wildlife species, and human beings all around them. The PA Game Commission (PGC) has a very difficult job managing our deer population, since there are so many stakeholders involved with a wide-variety of opinions on deer. I still remember my first Wildlife Course at Penn State when the Professor told us, "PA whitetails basically have two predators: a bullet or a bumper!" and "Bambi doesn't practice birth control." While large predators such as black bear, coyotes, and bobcats prey on fawns and may take down some mature deer; statistically, they are not taking enough to keep the population in check across the entire Commonwealth. The truth is recreational hunting and deer-vehicle collisions are the primary sources of deer mortality; unless you want to go with nature's own unforgiving cyclical population management system of peaks and crashes, due to starvation and disease. The allocation of PA antlerless licenses across multi-county Wildlife Management Units (WMUs) spread across the state is deer management at the macro-level.

Last week, we thoroughly covered how to obtain the antlerless tag(s) you desire in the four upcoming rounds when licenses will be issued. Unfortunately, the PGC can't dictate where hunters are going to fill their antlerless tags, since 83.7% of PA is private property and habitat quality, deer density, and hunter access varies considerably. I look back on one of our first field trips as PSU Wildlife Majors in Sep. 1983 when they took us to a farm that primarily raised high-quality alfalfa for the horse community. Looking out across hundreds of acres of alfalfa, which was 12 to 16-inches tall, it all appeared uniform. Then they showed us a small plot that was fenced off, "a deer enclosure," where the alfalfa grew 24 to 36-inches tall. The point was the deer were eating half the farmer's alfalfa crop across the entire farm and that translated into roughly \$55K in lost income annually (with an inflation calculator, that's \$160K in today's dollars). No small business can take that kind of hit to its bottom-line and survive, so you can realize why some farmers are not happy with deer when it comes to damage to their hay, corn, soybeans, or other crops. Similarly, larger multi-acre

"deer enclosures" on forested land clearly show how deer broadly impact the regrowth of small trees and their species composition. So, timber companies and forest land owners are frequently in favor of reduced deer numbers to permit vibrant forest regrowth with an ample understory.

The PGC has two programs to help target antlerless deer numbers on specific properties. The first is the Deer Management Assistance Program (DMAP) where hunters can obtain additional antlerless tags for enrolled properties (private properties, political subdivisions, PA state parks, and even PA state game lands) starting on Monday, Aug. 11, 2025 at 8 AM. DMAP seasons coincide with other deer hunting seasons, but this year will also include an extended firearms season for antlerless deer from Dec. 26, 2025 thru Jan. 24, 2026. Please see Page 29 of the PA 2025-26 Hunting & Trapping digest for more details. Second is the Ag Tag program, formerly called the "Red Tag" program, which is designed to help farmers experiencing excessive crop damage. The liberal antlerless-only Ag Tag season is set for Aug. 1, 2025 thru Apr. 15, 2026 and new for 2025-26, Ag Tags can be used during all established deer seasons. See Page 30 of your Hunting Digest for more details. If you do hunt with a DMAP or Ag Tag to help specific landowners lower their antlerless numbers, please consider donating a deer to Hunters Sharing the Harvest (PA's venison donation program) to help provide those in need a high-quality protein source.

Early bear seasons (muzzleloader, archery, and special firearms for senior and junior hunters) have been highly effective in increasing the bear harvest in recent years, so this year's archery bear season has been shortened to one week, Oct. 18-25, 2025. Early bear muzzleloader and special senior/junior bear firearms seasons will once again be only three days, Oct. 23-25, 2025. This year's total number of elk licenses for the upcoming three seasons (archery, general, and late firearms) is 140, which includes 65 bull tags and 75 cow tags. The suspense for applying for an elk license is Sun., July 13, 2025, and the drawing will be Sat., July 26, 2025. For those who elect to head north to pursue "the trophy of PA small game," there is now a season limit of three snowshoe hares during the six-day season, Dec. 26, 2025 thru Jan. 1, 2026.

Now's when the old Heinz Ketchup jingle, "A-N-T-I-C-I-P-A-T-I-O-N," goes through my mind for our upcoming 2025-26 hunting seasons. Can you feel it too?

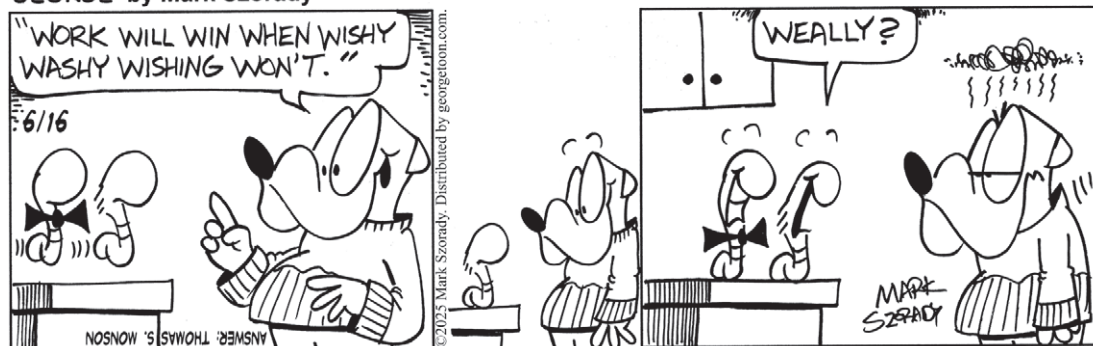


Even Exchange by Donna Pettman

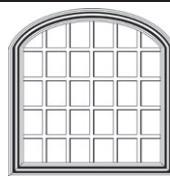

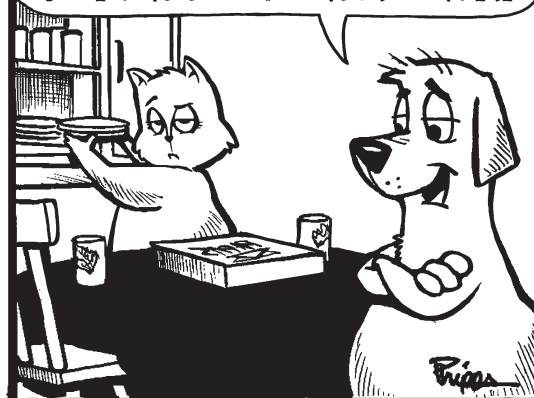

Two faces at the table stood out—one contorted by bitter anger, the other twisted in emotional pain. A reunion of old friends had just erupted into shouting, with one woman berating another for her beliefs. The contention continued until the first woman stomped out of the restaurant, leaving the other shaken and humiliated.

Are we really living in a time when a difference of opinion can't be tolerated? Just because two people can't agree doesn't mean that either is evil. Speech that's harsh or unyielding is never persuasive, and strong views shouldn't overcome decency or compassion.

Jesus indicated that an identifying characteristic for believers in Him is the love we have for each other (John 13:35). While pride and anger can easily derail us, they're in direct contrast to the love God wants us to show to others.

It's a challenge not to blame others when we lose control of our emotions, but the words "as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone" show us that the responsibility for living a life that reflects Christ's character can't be shifted to anyone else (Romans 12:18). PROPER RECYCLING • RECYCLING MYTHS

A Guide to doing it right in Lawrence and Mercer Counties



Recycling has evolved, becoming integrated into all aspects of our society and economy and a way of life for most people. Recycling became commonplace almost three decades ago, but many myths and misconceptions about it have persisted through the years.

Myth 1: Recycling should be free, My Recyclables are worth something.

This is a long-standing myth that pre-dates mainstream recycling. Prior to around 1990 organizations and groups could fund raise by collecting items such as glass bottles, newspapers, and cans. These materials had some value for collection at the time.

A major selling point in the early days of recycling was that our municipalities could make enough money from the sale of recyclables to pay for recycling programs. This quickly turned out to not be true, but this information became a persistent myth.

The influx of materials from new recycling programs overwhelmed the fledgling markets. The law of supply and demand activated and increased volumes of materials going through the programs diminished the value of many materials.

Some materials such as aluminum and steel cans retained value which is why many people collect and redeem their own cans. Think about it - if your plastic, paper and other recyclables had any value - wouldn't we see more people collecting and turning them in for money as we do with aluminium cans?

The recyclables in your bin are worthless in their current state. Surprised? read on...

Myth 2: My municipality or hauler is making money on my recyclables

Unless your municipality or hauler owns a material recovery facility, the technical term for a recycling center, they are not making money on your recyclables. There is a significant cost to get a recycling truck and driver to your home and transport your materials to recycling center. Then the trash must be removed, and the remaining recyclables must be sorted, separated by type, and baled by expensive equipment. Only after this process do the materials have value and are ready to be marketed. Think of recycling as "urban mining". Instead of raw materials being extracted from the earth and refined before they can be used, recycling provides raw materials that need minimal processing. Perhaps the biggest advantage to recycling is the energy saved and consequently the money saved by energy avoidance.

Recycling centers generate a profit but financial success in recycling can be difficult even

when recycling markets are good. Aluminum cans and cardboard are materials that usually keep recycling centers' budgets in the black.

Myth 3: If I put something in my recycling bin they will find a way to recycle it at the recycling center.

This is known as "wishcycling" and is one of the biggest problems plaguing recycling. Unacceptable items (a nice way of saying "trash") must be removed from the true recyclables and landfilled or incinerated. The average contamination rate is approximately 25% meaning that one in four items placed out for recycling must be removed to be disposed of properly. It is estimated that 20% of the cost of recycling is used to address trash placed in recycling bins.

There are many reasons why people place trash items into recycling bins. Some people have good intentions and believe they are helping by putting these items into their recycling bins. In some situations, education is lacking and people genuinely do not know what to recycle. There are also people who are just cheap and put trash into their recycling bins to avoid paying for proper disposal. This can be a major problem for volumebased programs where people have to buy bags/tags or are only permitted to put out a limited amount of regular trash collection. The result in this situation is people who are properly participating are paying for the people who are not.

Be sure to follow the rules for your program and keep in mind there may be differences between haulers and even neighboring municipalities depending on what recycling center is used. In general, all local programs collect plastic bottles and jugs (if it's not a bottle/jug it's trash!), metal cans, cardboard, magazine, and newspaper.

If it's not listed as recyclable for your program do not put it in your recycling bin!

Myth 4: Pizza boxes are recyclable.

You're half right on this one. The lid, as long as it is clean, can be torn off and recycled but the greasy bottom is trash. Grease and food residue is a problem for paper recyclers and can result in entire batches of paper pulp being ruined.

Myth 5: It's plastic so it is recyclable.

Plastic is one of the most confusing materials when it comes to recycling and is often "Wishcycled": Locally, recycling programs accept plastic bottles and jugs. The key words are "bottles and jugs". That means no clam-shell (food take out) containers, butter tubs, yogurt cups, party cups, toys and so forth. What is a bottle/jug? Think plastic primarily with screw top lids (sport drinks, condiments, detergent

bottles, shampoo, milk, and soda pop) and with the top section being narrower than the bottom.

The recycling symbol containing a number that is found on many plastic items is also misleading. This symbol has nothing to do with recycling; its purpose is to identify the plastic's resin. Promoting plastic recycling by number is still very popular. Most local programs accept #1 and #2 plastic, but, it still has to be a bottle or jug!

Plastic recycling is limited because the chemical make up and physical properties of plastic vary. Plastic may have UV stabilizers, flame retardants, hardeners, or softeners. Different resins melt at different temperatures. Quantity of material is also important. Plastic bottles and jugs make up almost 90% of residential plastic. Plastic is a light material that doesn't compact well. This impacts transportation which relies on weight and quantity to make recycling a particular material cost-effective.

Another challenge to plastic recycling is that some plastic items consist of multiple layers of different plastic. Drink and food pouches contain different layers and it is not uncommon for clamshell containers to have a lid that is a different plastic resin than the bottom.

Unfortunately, for most plastic, markets do not exist or they are far and few between because of the chemical and physical complexities of plastic.

Myth 6: Recycling programs are all the same.

Recycling programs can vary significantly. Recycling centers, the proximity to available markets, and ability to transport materials all factor into what can be recycled locally. Residents that live in or near metropolitan areas can usually recycle a broader range of items because of the number of households, and therefore, greater quantities of materials as well as the availability and proximity to manufacturers that can use recycling feed stocks. Residents that move are often surprised by differences in recycling programs between states and even nearby communities.

Myth 7: It has a recycling symbol on it so I can put it in my recycling bin.

The recycling symbol is one of the most easily recognizable symbols. It is frequently used indiscriminately on items, which leads to confusion. It may indicate recyclability or that an item contains recycled content. Just because

an item has a recycling symbol does not mean that it is recyclable in your local program. Be sure to recycle only what is the list of acceptable materials provided to you by your municipality or hauler! Don't rely on the recycle symbol.

Myth 8: Recycling will save me money.

This myth ties together with some of the other myths already discussed. In the early days of recycling, we were told we could save money by recycling. Our expectation is a lower trash/recycling bill that puts more money into our pockets. Costs have risen over the past decades and where recycling used to be "free" it now has a cost to it. Recycling does save us money - but not how we think. Recycling saves us money by lowering the cost of the products we buy. Energy, resources, transportation, and processing, all elements of manufacturing, are expensive. Recycling saves significant amounts of these, because mining, extraction, and refining raw materials is expensive. This saves businesses money, which in turn results in lower prices of the items we purchase. We may not directly see the money that we "saved" in our pockets, but it is there!

Myth 9: Plastic bags are recyclable so I can put my recyclables in them.

Plastic bags are a nightmare at the recycling center and plastic bags that end up there will NOT get recycled. Plastic bags must be ripped open to release their contents and get tangled in the cogs, gears and conveyers of recycling centers. It is not uncommon for recycling centers to shut down multiple times a day to remove them. Plastic bags are an expensive problem for recycling centers.

The good news is that plastic bags are very recyclable, but they have to go to the right place. Many local grocery and department stores accept plastic bags for recycling. Be sure to recycle your plastic bags, just don't put them in your recycle bin!

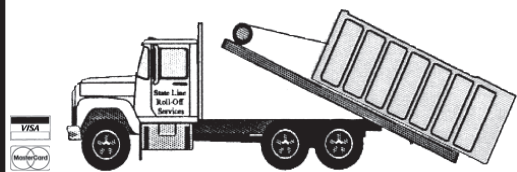

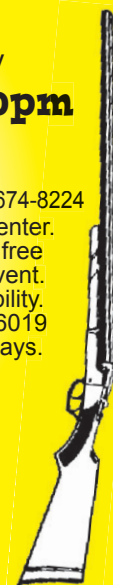

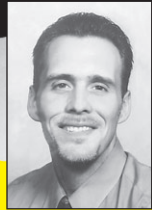

DEAR PAW'S CORNER:
I took my German
Shepherd "Maximilian"

for a walk at lunchtime today. Since we got back,
he's been limping and whining. I don't see any de-
bris on his paws, but the pads on his front paws feel
hot. Did he burn them somehow? – Greg B., Tampa
DEAR GREG: From his symptoms, it's very likely
that he burned his pads on a hot sidewalk or
street. You'll need to treat them quickly; first aid is
straightforward for this injury.

– Fill a shallow bowl with cold (but not icy) water.
Gently submerge your dog's paws in the water
– you may need to do one at a time and give him
treats throughout the process – for 10 to 15 min-
utes. (If he doesn't tolerate the water bowl at all,
wrap each paw in a cool cloth instead.)

– Wash his paws with cool, soapy water or disinfect
carefully, and pat them dry immediately.
– Put clean socks on his paws so he doesn't lick
them, and encourage him to rest.

Check Maximilian's paw pads every few hours. If
you see any sign of broken skin, blisters or infec-
tion, or if he is still limping tomorrow, take him to
the vet for further evaluation and treatment.

Burnt pads can happen very quickly in the sum-
mertime, especially in southern states. Walk dogs
in the early morning before sunrise or just after
sunset to minimize this risk, or keep them on the
grass and away from pavement during the day. Boo-
ties provide some protection, but can't always stop
heat transfer to paws. After each walk, check their
pads and wrap in a cool cloth for a few minutes, if
they feel warm. ©2025 King Features Synd., Inc.

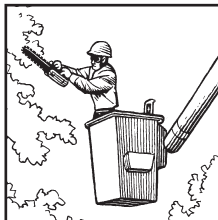

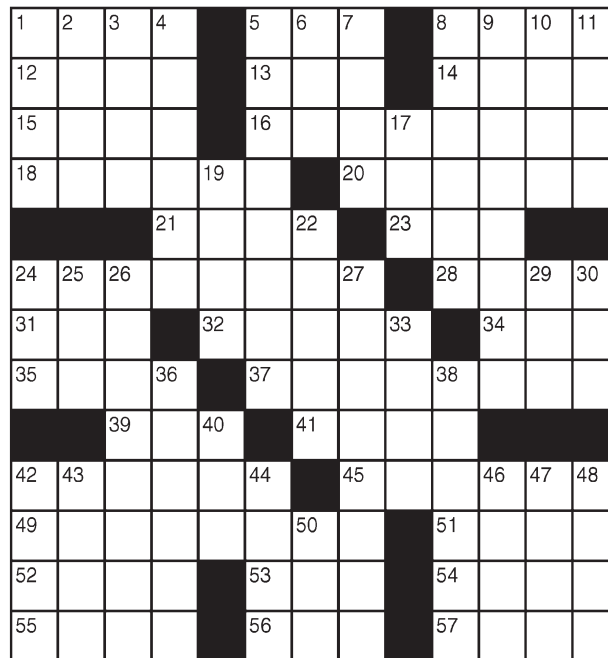
