

out, let stand in room temperature for 10 minutes. On a floured surface, roll out dough into a 12- to 14-inch circle. Transfer to a parchment-lined rimmed cookie sheet and chill about 15 minutes.

Toss together the fruit, sugar, flour, lemon juice, zest and salt. Remove dough from refrigerator. Mound fruit filling in the center of the dough, leaving a 2-inch border.

Fold border edge up and over fruit mixture in slightly overlapping pleats to form the sides of the tart, but leave the fruit center open 4-5 inches. Remember, it's rustic, so it doesn't need to look perfect! Brush dough with a little

water, sprinkle with sugar, and bake 50-55 minutes (or until golden brown).


Cool on rack, slide onto a serving plate, slice, and enjoy with vanilla ice cream!

Outdoor Opportunities By COL (Ret.) Grey D. Berrier II Trash Talk, Turf Wars, and Cat Calls

It's the Norm with the Birds

The United States recently celebrated Flag Day on Sat., June 14, and it was also the U.S. Army's official birthday. This year was very special, since

the Army proudly celebrated 250-years going back to 1775. What you may not know is some U.S. Army customs and practices pre-date the Army's official organization. One of those practices is "Stand To," a term even some soldiers may not be familiar with, unless they were in the Infantry or directly supported the Infantry, as was my case being an Artilleryman.

'Stand To" goes back to the 1750's and the French & Indian War. With the American Colonists sided with the British in that conflict, it was a common French & Indian tactic to attack one-hour before sunrise. Thus, having the element of surprise and ever increasing daylight as the attack progressed. "Stand To" was the tactical necessity to have every soldier awake, dressed (boots on), and in their fighting positions one hour before sunrise in the event a surprise attack came. This is before personal hygiene and breakfast is served. Many soldiers only experience "Stand To" in Basic Training, unless they are in Combat Arms. For almost 300-years, at least some of the U.S. Army has been practicing "Stand To" to remain vigilant.

I am blessed with the capacity to operate on very little sleep. That coincides with an ability to fall asleep within 2-minutes of closing my eyes. So, even if a typical night's shut-eye was only 4.5-hours, I was able to productively go for weeks with limited sleep. One of my tricks for being ready for "Stand To" out in the field, "up and at 'em" well over an hour before sunrise was to use the first birds' songs as a natural alarm clock. If you sleep with the windows open or work in a profession that requires an early start before daylight, especially during the summer heat, such as construction, farming, or work in a service industry where you have to be there for the early risers; you're familiar with how the birds get started singing, chirping, and announcing their presence well before there is any hint of daylight on the Eastern horizon.

While bird songs are delightful to listen to, tremendously varied, and a great means of identifying an often unseen source, there is more going on than meets the ear. While it may sound like a particular bird is just joyously announcing their presence to the world for evervone to hear, there is definitely directed communication involved in this early morning chatter and in the calls/ songs you hear throughout the day.

I'll use the American Robin as an example, since it is the most common

member of the Thrush Family and has adapted very well to living amongst human habitation. Most individuals are aware of its distinct black/brown coloration with an orangered breast. (Male robins have darker black heads with brighter breast feathers, while females have lighter brown heads with more subdued breast feathers.) Like many avian species, the males typically arrive several days or even a few weeks before the females. This is when the competition for breeding territories is fierce. Many of the bird calls you hear from robins and other species are announcements of their staked-out territories. This is when they get into "trash talk" with other members of their species, announcing "this is mine" and "there's going to be a fight, if you come into my space." If you think back, you can probably recall a battle or two over the past few months as the male robins got into "turf wars," fighting for territory as they seek productive feeding grounds and choice nesting sites. It's interesting how most bird conflicts are primarily within their own species and the home territories of many different species will overlap, since they often use very diverse nesting sites (ground, bush, or trees at various heights) and rely on different food sources (insects, seeds, nectar, etc.).

Once the males have established their territories, that's when the "cat calls" start. Each male is trying his best to attract a mate. "Hey, baby come over here and see what kind of living and feeding options my place can offer for raising a family!" "I'm the one you want to be with to perpetuate our species!" I know there are ornithologists who have made it their life's work studying bird calls, but if they can ever create an App that could listen to a bird's call and then give us an accurate translation, I think we would be shocked by how salty or sultry the birds are talking to each other in our midst. We would get an earful and possibly blush, but "trash talk," "turf wars," and "cat calls" are a way of life for the birds all around us.

Recently, I watched a feisty little ruby-throated hummingbird defend "his nectar feeder" from other hummingbirds (even though there was an abundance of nectar) and for the first time. I watched two crows seriously "throw down" with chest bumps, wing thrashings, and aggressive clawing. The birds around us are amazing and their calls/behavior warrant our attention!





timates that 150 million hot dogs are consumed on July 4. Though there's no corresponding estimate related to how many hamburgers Americans eat on July 4, various reports suggest Americans eat roughly 50 billion burgers annually, so it's fair to conclude many a burger will be consumed this Independence Day.

Coffee Shop Cup - Take your own reusable cup or travel mug. Disposable Eating Utensils - Opt for reusable plates, take-out containers, or silverware.

Paper or Plastic Lunch Bag - Take a lunch box or reusable bag.

Take-out Food - Bring reusable containers.

Single Use Plastic Water Bottles - Use refillable bottles.

Paper Towels - Use cloth towels.

Photocopies - Print double sided to save paper.

Notebooks - Buy paper that has post-consumer recycled content.

Household Batteries - Buy rechargeable batteries and a charger or use solar powered substitutes.

Recycle chargeable batteries instead of discarding.

Appliance, Tools and Equipment - Repair, share, and lend things such as equipment and tools.

Replacement products - Spend a little more to buy durable goods that will last longer and save money over time.






