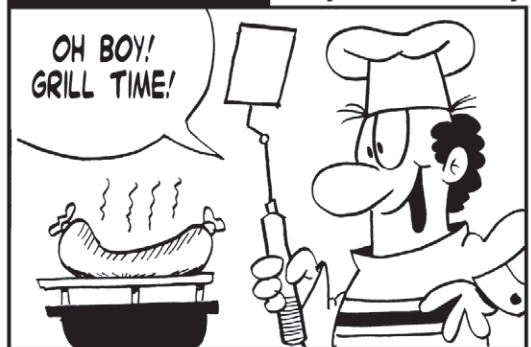

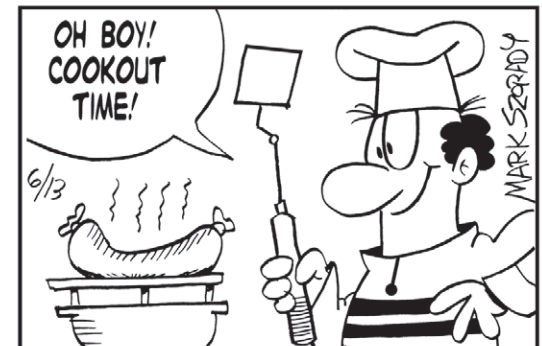

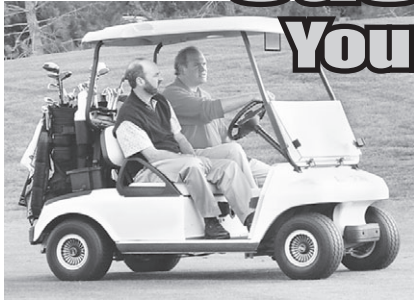

Outdoor Opportunities

Relaying What PGC Executive Director Steve Smith Shared is New for 2026-27



Did you ever notice how the setting for someone's public remarks can really influence how they come across to their audience? Elected officials are always moving press conferences to chosen locations to help frame an issue. Well, it wasn't by the PA Game Commission's design, but by the Pennsylvania Outdoor Writers Association's conference itinerary, that had PGC Executive Director Steve Smith come to the Ned Smith Center for Nature and Art in Millersburg, PA on Friday afternoon, May 15. In his first personal appearance with POWA since becoming PGC Executive Director in April 2024, Steve candidly addressed the 60+ assembled professional communicators from across the Commonwealth on what's new at the PGC, what changes are enacted for the upcoming 2026-27 PA hunting seasons, and then he fielded numerous questions from his audience. The Ned Smith Center's unique stone and timber architecture, coupled with its extensive forest backdrop, made it the perfect location to hear from the PGC's top leader on where things are currently at for wildlife and conservation in PA, and where we're going in the future.

Now, this may seem like an odd time to be talking about hunting, with the kids just finishing up their 2025-26 school year and everyone going into summer-mode, but the reality is PA 2026-27 hunting licenses and the corresponding first round of antlerless tags for PA residents go on sale on Monday, June 22, 2026, at 8 AM. We're getting very close, so I at least want to put getting your new PA 2026-27 hunting license on your radar screen. Keep in mind, PA hunting licenses correspond to the PA state fiscal year, not the calendar year like PA fishing licenses do, so new PA hunting licenses will be good from July 1, 2026 thru June 30, 2027. One of the biggest changes is Sunday hunting is now in effect year-round. So, when hunting seasons are open for specific game species, they will include the corresponding Sundays.

This means our regular firearms deer season will still open on the Saturday after Thanksgiving, but will now include three Sundays: opening weekend, middle weekend, and the final weekend. Bottom line is the regular firearms deer season will increase to 16 days, Nov. 28 - Dec. 13, 2026, the most days it's ever been. The one exception to Sunday hunting is waterfowl, since waterfowl are federally

regulated by the U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service, not the PA Game Commission. Another big change is that during the 2027 Spring turkey season, hunters will no longer be able to purchase a special Spring turkey license for a second bird. This is due to there

being five additional Sundays during the 2027 Spring turkey season and PGC biologists want to see the impact those five additional days have on turkey harvest numbers, before permitting anyone to take a second bird. While it is an ongoing concern, the 13 Sunday hunting days permitted during the 2025-26 PA hunting seasons did not cause noticeable conflicts between hunters and nonconsumptive outdoor enthusiasts (hikers, bikers, horseback riders, birders, etc.) and it is anticipated that making Sunday hunting the norm will still permit all outdoor enthusiasts to safely participate in their preferred outdoor activities without interfering with each other on public lands. One change I've personally made is I now keep a fluorescent orange baseball hat in my vehicle, so I can be highly visible if I'm out hiking, birding, paddling, etc. on a Sunday and I think others may be hunting in the same area.

Steve addressed the Wildlife Management Institute's ongoing study on the PA Game Comm. and the PA Fish & Boat Comm. possibly sharing some resources to gain efficiencies. (PA is the only state where fish and game fall under separate agencies.) Good news included the PA game fund balance currently sits at \$400M, primarily due to natural gas royalties from PA state game lands. This enables the PGC to reinvest that funding into habitat improvement projects (over 30,000 acres per year), strategic game lands purchases (to add new game lands where none existed and eliminate private inholdings in existing game lands when possible), and to conduct the sixth consecutive class of PA Game Warden cadets to help fill their ranks across PA's 67 counties. This funding balance has also permitted PA hunting licenses to remain the same price for 27-years. Can you think of anything else that has not gone up with inflation over that span? In future pieces, I plan on addressing other subjects Steve covered in more detail, such as the effect of West Nile Virus on ruffed grouse, Chronic Wasting Disease (CWD) ongoing impact on deer, and the impact of Avian Influenza on waterfowl and other bird species. It was good to hear the "State of the Union" regarding hunting, wildlife, and conservation directly from PGC Executive Director Steve Smith and my privilege to relay that information to you!

Q: Can you tell me about my deck of "Go Fish" children's playing cards? The box says "Copyright 1951" and "Mfg. by Ed-U-Cards N.Y.," but I haven't been able to find out more information about the company or the cards' value. I was also told that there is a toy museum that accepts donations of very old toys.

A: The Ed-U-Cards company started in the 1940s in Long Island, New York, and operated until the 1960s. As the name indicates, they made educational card games for children. These included flashcards and memory games to teach subjects like vocabulary, basic math, science concepts, and history. They also made related toys like puzzles and anagram tiles. Some of their card games were less overtly educational, like sports games and trading cards. Decks of Ed-U-Cards decks can be worth anywhere from about \$10 to \$50, depending on their subject matter and condition. Games with pictures of historical figures or famous fictional characters usually sell for the highest prices. There is a toy museum called the Strong National Museum of Play in New York (museumof-play.org) that accepts donations of old toys. They are known for their Toy Hall of Fame, which annually inducts a selection of classic toys.

• TIP: Plastic furniture from the 1950s often scratches. A good polishing with automobile wax might help cover the blemishes.

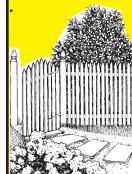

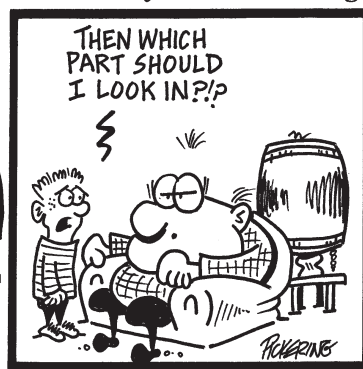
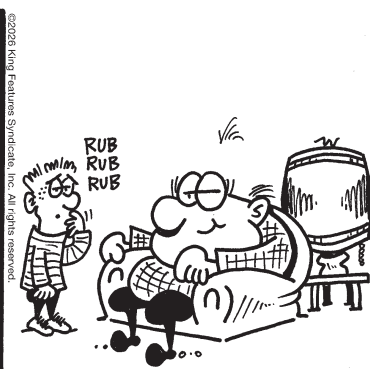

Serve up Caesar Salad Family-Style

Romaine hearts that are sliced in half with the stems attached, drizzled with oil and lemon juice, then tossed on the grill for a couple of minutes is and has been a clever, tasty side dish recipe that I snagged from my West Coast friends years ago. But now this popular idea of serving up romaine halves deserves another family-friendly presentation, so I decided to approach the idea with a classic Caesar salad in mind.

I halved the romaine hearts, but instead of firing up the grill, I let the kids arrange the crisp lengths cut side up on a huge platter. They then artistically topped each half with my fresh, homemade Caesar-like dressing (minus the traditional anchovy fillets and raw egg yolks) and capers and bacon bits for a tasty twist. Kids can cut pieces of bacon with kitchen scissors and let them fall as they may across each serving before they toss on the croutons. Success!

As an extra bonus, each portion goes from the serving platter to the plate without serving spoons, as guests "hand pick" their salad at the handy stem.

CAESAR SALAD FAMILY-STYLE

Serves 6

- 3 medium romaine lettuce hearts, cut in half lengthwise with the stem in place
- 1/2 cup salad dressing (below)
- 1/2 cup shredded Parmesan

- Bacon bits, capers, cherry tomatoes (optional)
- Freshly ground black pepper
- 2 cups croutons

Arrange romaine halves on a large platter. Spoon dressing over each half. Sprinkle with Parmesan. Add capers, bacon, cherry tomatoes and pepper according to taste. Top with croutons.



FAMILY-FRIENDLY CAESAR DRESSING

- 1 garlic clove, peeled and chopped
- 1/2 cup mayonnaise
- 1 tablespoon red wine vinegar
- 2 teaspoons Dijon mustard
- 2 teaspoons Worcester sauce
- 1/4 teaspoon black or white pepper
- 1/2 teaspoon salt

Combine ingredients in blender and process until well-blended. Cover and chill for at least 1 hour.

DEAR PAW'S CORNER: We had a scary incident a few weeks ago. Our puppy "Terah" got into the cabinet under the kitchen sink and chewed on a plastic spray bottle with cleaning solution in it. When the plastic cracked liquid went everywhere, and she licked up quite a bit of it. I caught her just after it happened and rushed her to the emergency vet. By the time we got there, she was shaking, drooling and vomiting. Terah stayed there for two days, getting IV fluids, and she was still weak and not very hungry when we brought her home. She's doing very well now, and I am putting child-safe locks on all the cabinets! Please warn your readers to keep pets away from cleaning products and other poisons. I never thought my puppy would chew through a spray bottle. – Billy in Asheville, North Carolina

DEAR BILLY: Thank you for this important reminder. Puppies are curious and love to chew on just about everything. The best way to keep them safe is to use "exclusion" measures like cabinet locks, high shelves and baby gates to prevent them from accessing cleaning products.

Cleaning products aren't the only danger to dogs, cats and other mammals in the house. Foods like avocados, onions, garlic, chocolate and grapes (including raisins) can be deadly. Xylitol, a sweetener used in sugar-free candies but also in unexpected places like peanut butter, is especially dangerous.

Some plants are deadly to cats and dogs and should be kept out of the house or well out of reach. And medications are another huge danger if left out where a pet can reach.
