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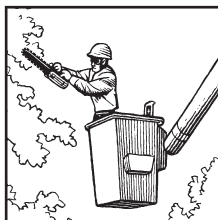

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Rodia began construction on his Watts Towers. Thirty-three years later, seventeen sculptures rose as high as thirty meters over Los Angeles. Musician Jerry Garcia was dismissive of Rodia's lifework. "That's the payoff," said Garcia. "That thing that exists after you're dead." Then he said, "Wow, that's not it for me."

So what was the payoff for him? His bandmate Bob Weir summed up their philosophy: "In eternity, nothing will be remembered of you. So why not just have fun?"

A wealthy, wise man once tried to find the "payoff" by doing everything he possibly could. He wrote, "I said to myself, 'Come now, I will test you with pleasure to find out what is good'" (Ecclesiastes 2:1). But he noted, "The wise, like the fool, will not be long remembered" (v. 16). He concluded, "The work that is done under the sun was grievous to me" (v. 17).

The life and message of Jesus radically counter such shortsighted living. Jesus came to give us "life to the full" (John 10:10) and taught us to live this life with the next one in view. "Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth," He said. "But

store up for yourselves treasures in heaven" (Matthew 6:19-20). Then He summed it up: "Seek first [God's] kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well" (v. 33).

That's the payoff—both under the sun and beyond. By Tim Gustafson

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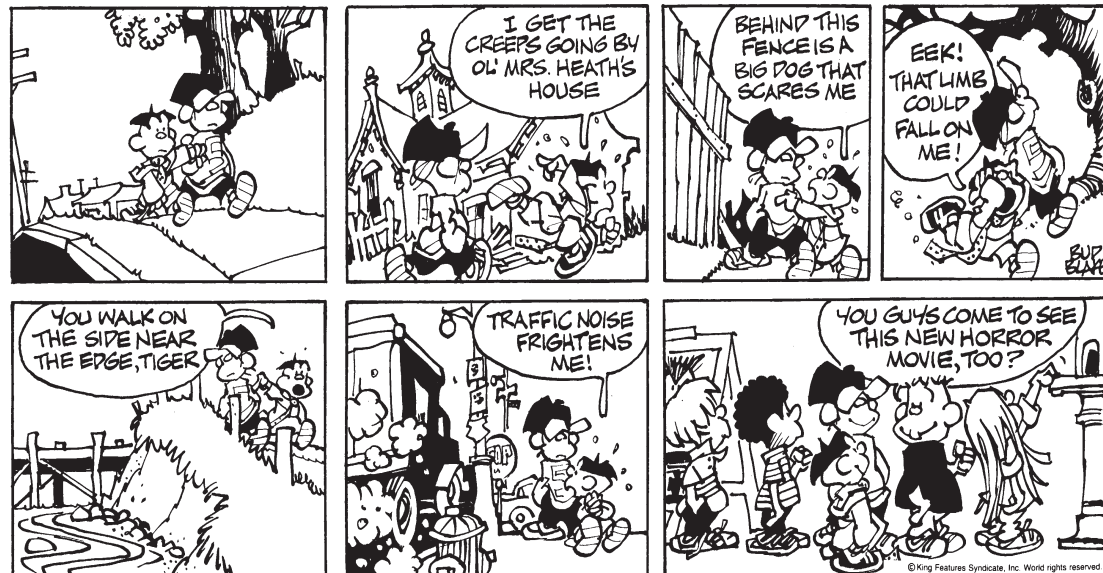

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DEAR PAW'S CORNER:
I recently read an article about a hiker who noticed another hiker's dog limping badly on a backwoods trail. The dog's paws were a mess, with long nails and pads that were scraped and tender. Yet

the owner said that he and the dog were pressing on to the end of the trail, two days ahead. Can you please make your readers aware that dogs aren't as tough as people think they are? An injured dog can't just keep going, because minor injuries can quickly become major, life-altering injuries in the woods. Sign me – Concerned in the Smokies

DEAR CONCERNED: I'm with you on this. While most dogs are energetic and agile on short walks around the neighborhood, long-distance hikes are a whole other animal.

During any outdoor activity, your dog's well-being dictates when it's time to stop and go home. Owners should be attuned to their dog's behavior at all times. When they show early signs of getting tired, that's the time to call it a day – before they begin limping or crying in pain.

Just as with human hikers, dogs need extensive physical conditioning before tackling a long hike. Start by gradually extending daily walks over several weeks or months. Take short day hikes so your dog becomes comfortable on uneven, variable terrain. After each hike, inspect their paws, brush debris and insects off their coat, and check their skin for ticks. Monitor them after hikes. If they seem unusually tired, give them a day off to recover.

Note that puppies up to 18 months should not be taken on walks or hikes of over 2 miles. Their bones are still developing, and overuse can cause permanent injuries. Senior dogs should also cut their mileage, and close attention must be paid to their hydration and energy levels.

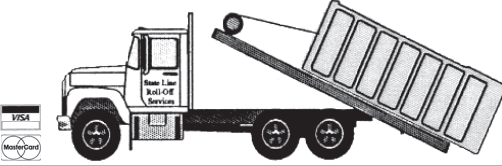


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Recipe Corner

APPLE CHEDDAR
SCONES

- 1 3/4 C. all-purpose flour
- 2 Tbsp. sugar
- 1 1/2 tsp. baking powder
- 1/2 tsp. salt
- 1/4 tsp. baking soda
- 1/3 C. cold butter or margarine
- 1 C. buttermilk
- 1 C. (4 oz.) shredded cheddar cheese
- 1 C. diced peeled apples

In a bowl, combine the first five ingredients. Cut in butter until mixture resembles coarse crumbs. Stir in buttermilk just until moistened. Gently fold in the cheese and apples. Turn onto a floured surface; knead 10 times. Pat into a 9" circle. Cut into eight wedges. Separate wedges and place on a greased baking sheet. Bake at 450° for 12-15 minutes or until golden brown. Yield: 8 scones

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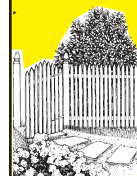

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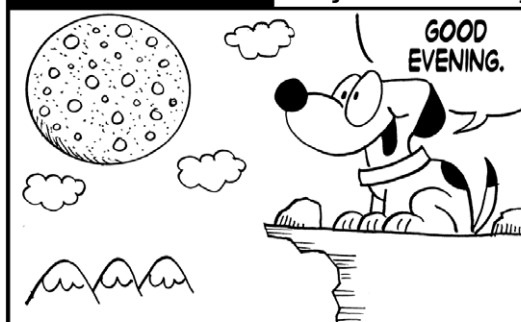

Don't fall for scam emails

I received an email from a company that I use for computer repair and malware protection. No surprise there; they've sent me annual emails over the years when it was time to renew the service. I opened the email and it was an invoice indicating they would be charging my credit card several hundred dollars today!

But I took a closer look. The area code of the phone number at the bottom of the invoice was not for the state where the real company is located. The address at the bottom of the invoice was for yet another state. The amount was wrong. The name of my service plan was wrong. And I knew that my subscription wasn't due to renew for several months. The email asked me to click a link to contact them to verify the information.

In other words, a typical scam involving a large amount of money and an urgency (today!) designed to get me to act quickly before I could think it through. To be sure, though, I called the real company using a number I knew, not the one in the email. Yes, they said, it was a scam, and yes, my account was fine. They were able to check my account and quoted to me information that I knew was accurate – the upcoming renewal date and the amount. They thanked me for letting them know and had me forward that email to their fraud department.

The question, of course, is whether the scammers really know I have a service plan with that company. Probably not. Chances are they send millions of those emails hoping someone will respond.

Bottom line with emails: Know your business transactions and subscriptions. Know when they are due to renew. Beware even if it's a company you know. Don't click anything. And call the company if you aren't sure it came from them. ©2026 King Features Synd., Inc.

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**Outdoor Opportunities***By COL (Ret.) Grey D. Berrier II***Often Overlooked, there is an Abundant**
Foundational Species for Hunters of all Ages

I learned a rather unsettling fact at the 2026 PA Outdoor Writers Association's annual conference, this past May. It didn't come from one of our well-known invited speakers, but rather from a PA Game Commission employee, who was in attendance and shared the information in a conversation. This individual revealed an alarming subject, that is apparently being discussed within the halls of PGC Headquarters on Elmerton Ave. in Harrisburg, but not being widely shared with the public at this point.

Everyone knows the number of active hunters is slowly, but steadily, declining in PA and across the United States. At one point, PA sold well over one million hunting licenses each year. Those days are past and in 2025, roughly 850,000 individuals purchased a PA hunting license (junior, adult, senior, or mentored, resident or nonresident). The alarming fact already being discussed is the number of active hunters in PA is projected to significantly drop to 550,000 within the next ten years as the "Baby Boom" generation (those born between 1946 and 1964) age out of hunting, due to illness, frailty, disinterest, or death. That's over 1/3 of today's hunters no longer purchasing a hunting license and heading afield. The ripple effects of such a momentous decline are significant socially, economically, and politically. Some of the PGC's largest funding sources are hunting license sales and the federal excise tax dollars (Pittman-Robertson Wildlife Restoration Act of 1937) coming back from the U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service, based on hunting license sales. Significantly less hunters means fewer sporting goods purchases and a major drop in individuals heading up to camps, which results in fewer purchases of groceries, gas, restaurant meals, and hotel stays in rural PA communities. Fewer hunters and fewer families with hunters in their numbers have resulted in the passage of widespread hunting restrictions and firearms unfriendly legislation in other states, and I personally don't want to see our beloved Commonwealth ever go there.

The PGC has tried numerous initiatives to reverse the trend and actively recruit new hunters or bring back individuals who hunted at one point and have stopped for one reason or another. There are mentored youth and mentored adult licenses, the BOW (Becoming an Outdoors Woman)

Program, and the Saturday Opener of our PA Firearms Deer Season was touted as an effort to get students and younger employees with low seniority afield. The challenges in getting new people involved in hunting are many. There are the equipment costs and the knowledge factor, if you weren't born into a family of hunters. There is the constant competition with smartphones, video games, social media, and youth sports. However, there is one factor many adult hunters (parents, grandparents, aunts & uncles) often don't consider when getting a younger family member involved in hunting. Today, everyone wants to be a deer and turkey specialist. With all the seasons, especially for deer, most hunters focus on those big game species and those species only. I've been guilty of this trap and like most experienced hunters, I can patiently sit still for hours from before first shooting light until dark, knowing the buck of a lifetime may come along and offer a shot.

Younger hunters and less experienced mentored adult hunters don't want that. To them that is BORING (and potentially a very cold or wet negative experience); and while they may not say it outright, it might be the reason they don't want to go hunting with you anymore or purchase a hunting license in future years. One answer is to get back to basics and take them squirrel hunting! It's simply a fact that whatever I'm hunting for, the majority of the time, the first mammal I see in the woods and the animal I typically see the most of throughout the day are squirrels. Less experienced hunters want to see game while afield and have opportunities to take a shot now and then. Squirrels (gray, fox, red, & black) are wily quarry and can be pursued with a rimfire rifle, shotgun, airgun, revolver, bow, or even a small caliber muzzleloader. Everything someone needs to know about deer hunting, they can probably learn from hunting squirrels. Since you can sit still on a stand (on the ground or elevated), still hunt (quietly walking through the woods), stalk (quietly sneaking up on a squirrel you've observed at a distance), or even call them to you. PA's squirrel season this year opens on Sep. 12, 2026 and runs through Feb. 28, 2027 (only excluding Christmas day). Squirrels are challenging for new hunters, experienced hunters, and older hunters who still want to head afield, but don't want the burden of dragging a deer out. Pursuing this small game species can potentially play a big part in the recruitment of new hunters and the perpetuation of hunting in PA. Why not take some time to try it this year for yourself!
